THIS HAS BEEN A YEAR OF EXPANSION FOR SWEETSER.

This effort focused on meeting the ever-growing behavioral health needs of our communities, especially in addressing Maine's youth mental health crisis.

We set out to reduce barriers to accessing mental health treatment and recovery services. We accomplished this through program launches and new physical location openings, expanding care to more corners of our state and specifically to underserved communities.

With over 10,000 Mainers on a waitlist throughout the behavioral health system, Sweetser is stepping up to meet this critical moment of need.

Sweetser's accomplishments included:

- Opening two new mental health and substance use clinics called Hope & Healing Centers in both Lewiston and Sanford
- Launching Maine's only Child Assertive Community Treatment program (Child ACT)
- Starting a transitional aged youth residential program in Saco
- Beginning a new adult residential program in Belfast
- Expanding our OPTIONS & Recovery Coach programs

The opening of our two additional Certified Community Behavioral Health Clinics garnered significant media attention and praise from lawmakers. Our Lewiston Hope & Healing Center was opened next to Just-In-Time Recreation as an important symbol of resilience as Maine continues to heal from the Lewiston mass shooting. These walk-in care centers enable us to serve hundreds more Mainers throughout York and Androscoggin Counties. As we have become demonstration sites for the state, the goal is for Sweetser to lead the way in the expansion of these centers to more counties.

This annual report gives you a glimpse into a year in which Sweetser carved out a clear path to strengthening our operations. We hope you find your own way to fuel our mission and amplify our collective impact through action. Sweetser looks ahead to building upon our expansion of services with an eye towards growth and sustainability to make recovery possible for all.

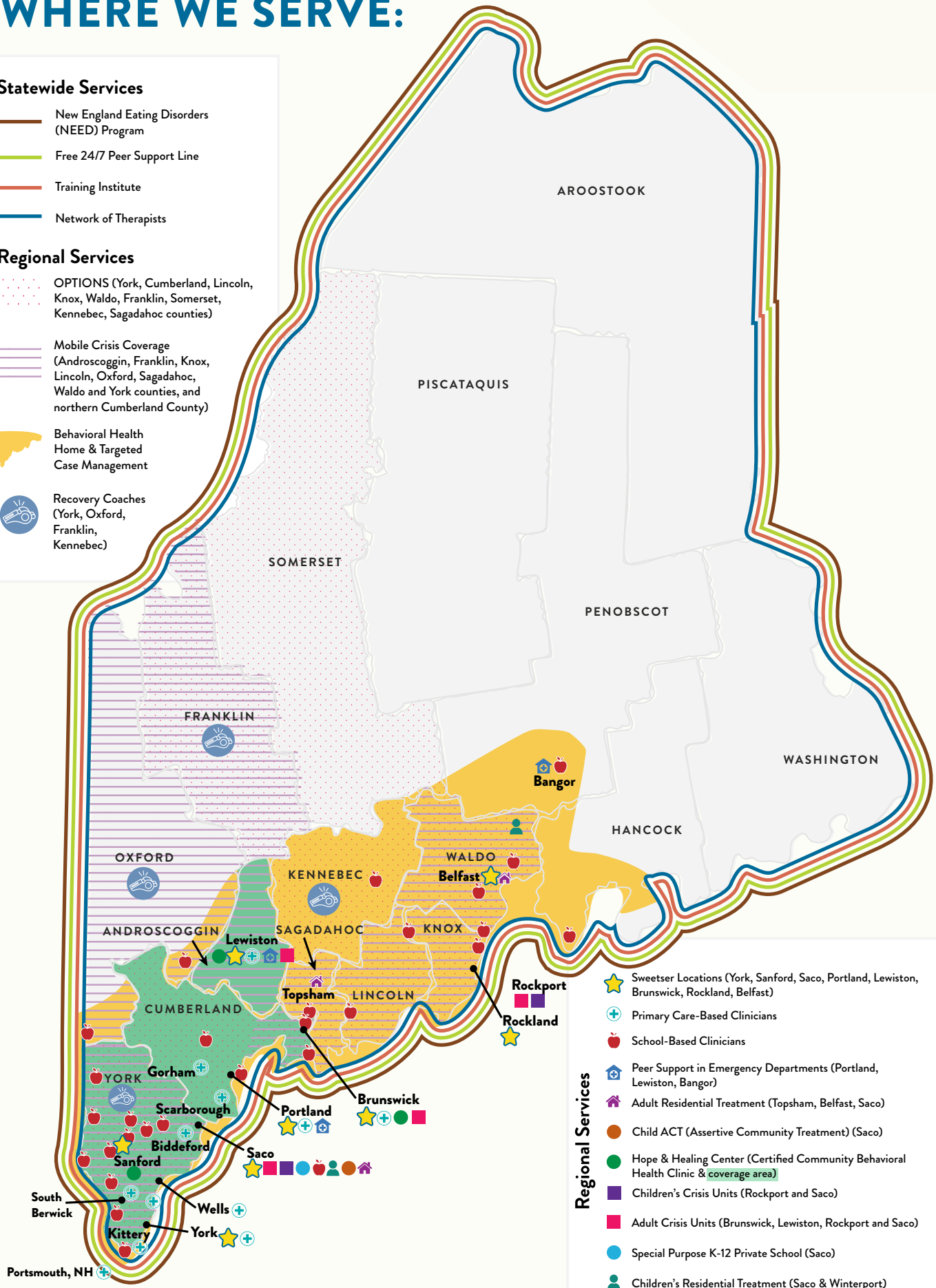

Re-Opening of Child Crisis

Sweetser has re-opened its Child Crisis Stabilization Unit in Saco after designing a truly therapeutic, trauma-informed environment for our clients. This reset allowed us to use an available building on our campus and set up the space in a way conducive to providing children with the care they require. This includes designated spaces for group therapy and using therapeutic colors throughout the unit.



Opening the only Child ACT Team

We opened the state's only Child Assertive Community Treatment program (Child ACT) following a federal report showing a critical gap in this service model to provide community-based programs for youth and their families. Child ACT is often referred to as a service for children with serious emotional disorders, helping to avoid costly hospitalization.

HOPE & HEALING CENTERS

In addition to our existing Brunswick clinic, Sweetser opened two additional Certified Community Behavioral Health Clinics in Sanford and Lewiston. These new Hope & Healing Centers enable us to serve hundreds more Mainers in need of mental health and recovery treatment throughout York and Androscoggin Counties.

All centers have walk-in hours with same day access, reducing barriers to critical services.

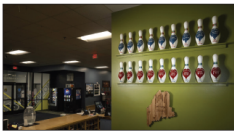

SHARING THE NEED TO SAVE SCHOOL-BASED THERAPY

OPINION

School-based therapy not financially sustainable without state support

Providers like mine are creatively subsidizing the cost of mental health services at public schools. That can't last.

To help satisfy the growing demand and need for preventive mental health services for young people in Maine, Sweetser is meeting the moment at a great financial loss. Last year, we lost \$376,000 on our school-based therapy services. So far this year, our program is operating at a \$428,000 deficit. These negative margins are unsustainable and they're being experienced by other providers as well. We prop up the cost of school-based therapy using other program revenues and donations because this is a best practice in treatment delivery.

According to a study by the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, young people are more comfortable accessing services through school-based clinics. Because children spend the majority of their day in educational settings, schools play a critical role in

Common-sense activities like meeting with educators about how to remove barriers to the students' learning, getting parental consent paperwork signed, traveling to families' homes for therapy, required continuing education training, documentation, family communication and dealing with urgent mental health or emotional crises that arise on campus are all not billable.

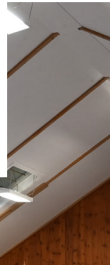

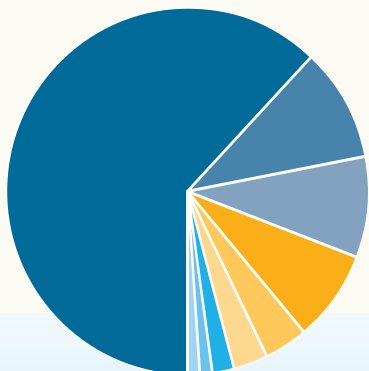
